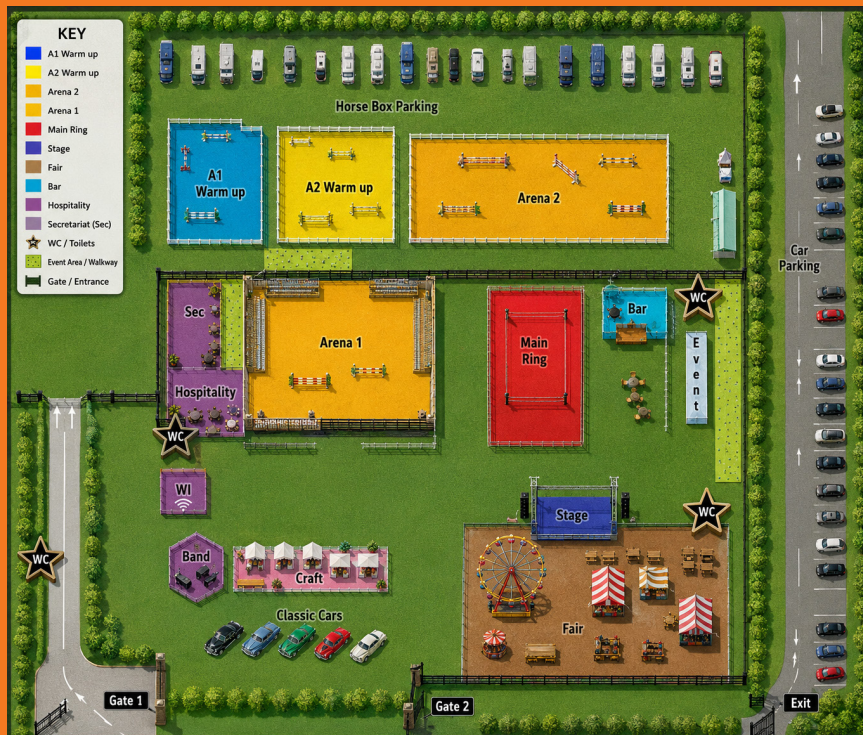

Messingham Horse & Foal Show Committee (MHFSC) reserves the right to vary the order & composition of the Horse Schedule and Show Programme and to decline entry to the showground without being required to give a reason.

Times may vary from those scheduled.

All persons participating in or attending the show in any way do so at their own risk.

MHFSC will not accept any legal liability whatsoever for any loss or damage to property, including the transmission of any infectious disease to any animal.

MHFSC will not accept legal liability for injuries to any person, except for death or personal injury arising from the negligence of MHFSC, its servants or agents.

MHFSC has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all persons on the show ground.

All persons on the showground are expected to do the same and to comply with all instructions of Show Officials and Stewards.

The Showground is laid out so that competitors with horses, and the members of the public are kept apart.

All persons attending the show must keep within designated areas. By entry to the showground all persons agree to be photographed or filmed.

The onus is on every person who suffers an injury whilst on the showground, to report a fall/injury to the on-site First Aiders AND Show Secretary.

The maximum speed on the showground is **5 MPH**.

WI TENT

Messingham WI was formed in 1931 and has enjoyed a long association with Messingham Show.

In the WI marquee we provide tea and coffee served in china cups and a wide range of homemade cakes traditionally the 'signature' of WI.

The marquee also houses the adult and children's competition entries. The adult categories are based on the traditional WI skills of making jams, pickles and cakes. The handcrafts section includes knitting, embroidery and hand and machine sewing.

There is a large floral section with categories suitable for beginners and the more experienced flower arrangers. Cups are awarded for certain categories and best school and best entry.

The children's work is displayed around the walls of the marquee where art work from Messingham School and four other schools from the surrounding area are displayed. After judging, each year group is awarded a first, receiving a rosette and certificate and second and third, receiving certificates.

WI meetings are held on the first Monday of the month, excepting bank holidays, at the village hall and start at 7pm. Visitors are most welcome to come and try a session without having to join immediately. Meetings are a mixture of speakers, demonstrations and workshops and there is an organised trip in July and a Christmas lunch.

6. In the event of there being insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld.
7. Show Jumping objections must be made to SDPOC officials within 15 minutes of completion of the class in writing and accompanied by a cash deposit of £30.00. This deposit will be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
8. All persons participating in the show in any way do so at their own risk. MHFSC will not accept any legal liability whatsoever for any loss or damage to property, including the transmission of any infectious disease to any animal. MHFSC will not accept legal liability for injuries to any person, except for death or personal injury arising from the negligence of MHFSC, its servants or agents.
9. MHFSC has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all participants. All persons on the showground are expected to do the same and to comply with all instructions of Organisers, Officials and Stewards.
10. The showground is laid out so that competitors and members of the public are kept apart. All persons attending the show must keep within designated areas.
11. No person(s) shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any class /competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other competitors, show officials or members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
12. Any and all trophies or silverware mentioned in this schedule are to be taken away after awarded by the judge. Sashes and rosettes will be presented to winners to be kept. By entry competitors agree to be photographed.
13. The onus is on every competitor / rider who suffers a fall, or anyone who suffers an injury whilst on the showground, to report the fall / injury to the on-site Paramedics AND Horse Show Secretary or SDPOC Official (Show jumping).
14. All riders / competitors are required to make a contribution of £3.00 to help pay for the Paramedic cover provided on the day.
